The illustrated relief printing is created by Danish artist Torben Stig Larsen using a Norup etching press.

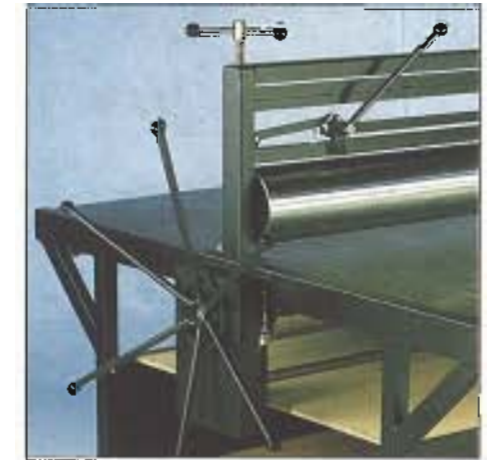
